Explaining Tarot to Your Cat

And Other Ways to Become a Better Reader

Do you want to be a better reader?

Extrapolate.

No more and no less.

It's easier said than done, but it is the key to help you go a bit beyond the surface.

If you cultivate this skill, it doesn't matter if you're reading Tarot, an Oracle, or someone's rear end (yes, there's a guy that divines by looking at people's anuses, so next time you feel weird about coming out of the witchy closet, think about that!) The more I teach, the more I think about my reading system and the more I get to the conclusion that there are no separate folders in my brain for Tarot, Lenormand, or Belline. Sure, I have memorized the meanings of each system, but still, the skills that I use come from the same source.

I'm going to ask you to think of fettuccini (and no, I haven't lost my mind; I promise there is a point here).

Now, think of dumplings.
And now, think about girasoli gorgonzola.

I don't know how it happened, or if it even happened this way, but I'd like to believe that one happy day, someone saw pasta dough, thought of a dumpling, and said, "Hey, we're onto something here."

What I want to get at is that there are no specific instructions for each thing. There is taking what we already know and transforming it into something else.

So don't think of the meanings of your cards as girasol, gorgonzola, or fettuccini alfredo. Think of them as flour, water, and eggs, and depending on the ingredients at hand (your question, your context, your querent), make with it what you can.

I would like to introduce you to a handful of ways in which you can cultivate the skill to extrapolate the meanings of your cards to bend those meanings as needed.

1 - Interrogate.

What is happening in this card? What is it a symbol of? What is the motivation of the characters depicted? In the Three of Cups, we have people dancing together so when do people dance? Probably in a celebration, but also in rituals, or when they want to get someone's attention and feel attractive, or when they are feeling some other sort of way, or they want to lose weight or stay active, but there's a storm on the outside.

2 - Apply your conclusions to an unrelated situation.

Now we are clear on what type of situations you could find a Three of Cups, but what about a Three of Cups in a funeral? People aren't going to dance there, but there can still be a celebration of sorts. And how about the Three of Cups in jail? Maybe it is a visit? Time outdoors?

3 - Use word associations.

This might take you to an unexpected place. Get paper and pen and draw a card, and most importantly, don't judge yourself. Just write down the first word that you think about and then the next

work that you think about when you read what you wrote, and keep going until something clicks. Here's The Magician, and I think "manipulation," next up, I think "machine," next up, I think "engineer." Wait... Could The Magician be a machine? I don't think so. But, an engineer? Hmmmm...

4 - Pretend to teach someone else (or do it!)

Pick a card and pretend to explain it to a child.

Now to your grandma. And now, to your cat.

Yes, you may feel silly, but trust me. Pull a card and think about how would you, in their understanding of the world, explain the Seven of Swords to your cat.

"Hey, cat! Do you know when I cuddle you and give you a treat, and then another one, and another one, until suddenly you are in the Carrier, and next thing you know, you're at the vet's office with a thermometer up your asterisk? Well, my furry friend. That's the Seven of Swords!"

5 - Experiment.

Read on anything and everything. Regardless of how outlandish it may sound. And interpret the cards however you can. Again, this takes not being afraid of ridicule and letting your creativity work.

Ask, "What do clouds smell like?" and you pull a card. Let's say it's Strength, and you think of a lion's breath. Does it make sense? No, it doesn't, but that's an association that's now stored in your brain. So maybe when someone comes in for a reading and asks why their Tinder date didn't follow up with them, and you draw Strength, that too-garlicky ravioli al pesto they ordered for dinner may not have been the best choice.

In conclusion, taking your reading practice too seriously and scholarly can end up being detrimental when it comes to applying it to the real-life issues that you or your querents want to know about. So, be willing to think out of the box and expand on those meanings despite not always finding something relevant. Though you never know when the weirdest association may come in handy.

NODES

The Themes of Your Chart

by Anthony Perrotta

I AM OFTEN ASKED about the Nodes in my practice, and this is something that I personally have explored in depth over the last many years. To me, the Nodes bring so much to the table in astrology. In keeping with the idea of story-telling for this issue, the Nodes are a big part of the story of your chart, as they represent the themes. From the Nodes we gain perspective and can see the big picture of the why, how, and what. To me, everything in the chart supports these calculated lunar mathematical points. They are the spots where the Moon's orbit intersects the plane of the ecliptic, represented in our charts as calculations and not actual celestial bodies.

So what are the Nodes exactly? They are often called the Dragon's Head and Dragon's Tail. They look like horseshoes and sit exactly 180° away from one another. They will only ever be in opposition to one another. They represent our fate, destiny, and purpose—they are the points of past and future at the intersection of our present. Because of their opposing nature, they are often viewed as polarities, where we are told to ignore or release the South Node (the past, the comforts, the limitations) and solely embrace the North Node (the new direction, the future, the “purpose”). However, I believe that it is through the South Node we can embrace and find meaning in our North Node. We can't simply ignore the South Node in totality, as it holds the keys to unlock the potential that is held in the North Node. Yes, there are areas in the South Node

we must let go, but there are pieces we can celebrate there, too.

In short, the North Node represents the kinds of experiences we must work to develop for our own growth. It may feel uncomfortable, unfamiliar, or a bit difficult for us. This makes sense, as it will be a fresh start for us in some ways. From a soulful perspective, this is what we must do in order to apply what we have learned from past lessons. It can show us newfound insights, new successes, and new places of interest. It can deepen our understanding of ourselves and open doors where we thought none existed before. Of course, it isn't easy to see the North Node in ourselves, as it is foreign. But by seeing it from where we stand at the South Node point in our chart, we can see the relationships they have to one another. It is a place to look to for our own expansion.

The South Node, in turn, represents those experiences and qualities that come naturally to us. Perhaps in some cases, they get too much attention or we fall back on them in moments of fear or uncertainty. Thus, it can be a place of stagnation and comfort. Traditionally, the South Node can be a point of undoing unless we develop the North Node experiences and qualities. So, we see the connection in the two. It isn't so much an either/or, as it is a “yes, and.” It can be through the lens of the South Node that we can find journeying toward the North Node. They are the lessons of our soul's

past. We bring them into this incarnation to help us and remind us of where we have come from. Thus, consciously working on these life lessons is said to bring us a sense of fulfillment. If we rely too heavily on our South Node at the expense of developing our North Node, we may feel that we are repeating patterns. Cycles are meant to be broken, so new ones can be formed.

When looking at the Nodes, it is important to see what signs they occupy, as well as what Houses they reside in. Interactions or aspects to the nodes take more of a backseat, unless there is a strong conjunction/opposition to either. The signs will inform the “what,” while the Houses will tell you “where.” For example, if you have North Node in Sagittarius, you may be asked to step into your truth and learn to take risks. But to find where that may need to happen, then check the House it sits in. In contrast, the South Node in Gemini may require you to use your adaptability and flexibility to achieve your goals, but be careful of taking in too much information. Not everyone’s perspective or ideas are for you and vice versa. That can cloud your own personal truth or expression of said truth. To understand where you may get trapped in this behavior, look to the House that your South Node is in. The North Node in Sagittarius requires focus and taking chances on yourself. To live authentically, someone with this nodal placement will have to be willing to listen to themselves first and foremost, and seek adventure to better their understanding of the world and themselves overall.

As I mentioned, aspects are more of a secondary point for the Nodes. However, any planets/points conjunct or opposite the Nodes tightly will be important. For example, if your Moon is conjunct your South Node, you may find it hard to emotionally step away from the past. You could be nostalgic, thus, keep yourself in repeating patterns based on comfort and the fear of the newer experiences. The quote “it’s better to deal with the devil you know than the one you don’t,” comes to mind here.

However, the aversion to stepping into your power can keep you feeling limited. There can be a karmic or past connection with the mother or the nurturer in your life/the maternal line. You could feel stagnated by this energy or soothed to the point of inaction. They could be a big support for you but that may also lead you to feeling too comfortable to take any chances on yourself.

To see what themes may come up for you in your chart based on your nodes, look below at this simple breakdown.

Nodes By Sign

North Node in Aries – Embrace identity, new experiences, and autonomy. Find your fighting spirit and learn to go after what you want. Release indecision, losing boundaries, and lack of confidence. Celebrate your diplomacy and tact. Enjoy your ability to connect with others.

North Node in Taurus - Embrace stability, security, and self-reliance. Find your value and learn to stand in your worth. Release enmeshment, emotional chaos, and others’ pains. Celebrate your intimacy and intensity. Enjoy your ability to direct your power.
